<b>SUBJECT:</b>	<b>NIOSH Approval Label Misprint on Panther and Cougar/Puma SCBA</b>
<b>DATE:</b>	<b>November 1, 2008</b>
<b>PRODUCTS AFFECTED:</b>	<b>All Survivair® SCBA manufactured between October 1, 2001 and October 1, 2008.</b>

This Technical Bulletin provides information regarding a misprint found on the NIOSH approval label affixed to all Panther and Cougar/Puma SCBA manufactured between October 1, 2001 and October 1, 2008. The label in question is affixed to the SCBA backpack, on the cylinder side, in the lower left hand area behind the cylinder support. The label part number is 995764 REV. A 05-01


The misprint is the duration time listed for the sixty (60) minute SCBA, (TC-13F-287 60 MINUTE 4500 PSIG). It was misprinted as “50 MINUTE” duration.

During annual flow testing, inspect the NIOSH approval label for this misprint. If you find that the label is misprinted please call Sperian Customer Service at (800) 821-7236 and request replacement NIOSH labels as needed. Remove the misprinted label and replace with the corrected label (correction is asterisked and highlighted below).
